The Infosys contract and project life cycle Dynamics AX preconfigured client solution transforms the four major opportunity areas of our client: contracts, projects, logistics, and billing.




Figure: Contract and Project Life Cycle Solution Architecture

Solution category	Functional overview
Contracts	 Preconfigured end to end contract life cycle encompasses industry best practices, Infosys expertise, and client experiences
Projects	 Multiple versions of the required forms are pre-built to support the use and maintenance of multiple bill rates per employee The solution takes the best capabilities of these forms and consolidates them into a single form that offers a pre-built capability to maintain consolidated projects and payroll timecard
Logistics	 Provides a single integrated system to handle logistics No GL impact, as the stock status and inventory value remain visible Accurate data inputs available to perform inventory valuation, inventory optimization, stock reconciliation, and spend analysis
Billing	 Solution provides accurate and timely billing to customers by: Applying multiplier based on expenditure types to a base billing rate. The base rate can be either from employee rate schedule, job rate schedule, or from the HR base rate defined in HRMS Applying burden cost and uplift amount
